where will i live?

Incoming undergraduates are randomly assigned to an on-Grounds housing area by our assignment software. All first-year areas are air conditioned.

First-year housing possibilities include hallway-style buildings in our Alderman Road and McCormick Road areas, Gooch/Dillard and Alderman Road suite-style buildings, and residential colleges (learn more at housing.virginia.edu/residential-colleges!).

when should I apply for housing?

The first-year housing application typically opens on May 1 and should be completed by June 1. There is no advantage to applying early, as long as you meet the deadline.

what is an ra?

Every student living on Grounds has a Resident Advisor (RA) who lives within the residential community. These student leaders are committed to building strong communities, from offering structured programs to providing informal peer advising.



what about my second year?

Live on Grounds your second year for the best combination of location, pricing, and connecting to the **UVA** community!

Upperclass on-Grounds housing options include apartments, hallway-style buildings, residential colleges, and language houses. The priority application deadline is typically in January of each year, with online student room selection in January and February.
