*Guaranteed Admission Agreement (GAA) options for students in the Virginia Community College System.



Guaranteed Admission Eligibility Basics

- Complete an AA, AS, or AA&S at a school in the Virginia Community College System.
- Earn a minimum of 24 credits post high school graduation.
- Earn 45 transferrable VCCS credits, and 54 transferrable credits overall (i.e. may include AP or IB).
- 3.4 minimum cumulative GPA with all grades of C or higher, and B or higher in English (also math and science for Engineering).
- Specific coursework (school dependent):
 - College of Arts and Sciences
 - School of Engineering and Applied Science
 - School of Nursing: RN to BSN
- Additional requirements as outlined by the school.

The Application

DEADLINES

- Spring: October 1
- Given Fall: March 1

REQUIRED

- Common Application (including the essays) commonapp.org
- <u>ALL</u> college transcripts from <u>every</u> institution attended
- Official high school transcript or official GED score report (regardless of when you graduated from high school)

RECOMMENDED

Mid Year Grade Report by mid-October for spring applicants or mid-March for fall applicants

OPTIONAL

- Academic Recommendation
- AP or IB subject scores

NOT REQUIRED

SAT or ACT

UVA DEFERRED PROGRAM: YEAR IN WISE

Criteria:

- Students must be from Virginia.
- Must be placed on the waitlist for the College of Arts and Sciences at UVA to be eligible.

UVA DEFERRED PROGRAM: YEAR IN WISE

To guarantee transfer to UVA after one year:

- Enroll at UVA Wise as a first-time, full-time student
- Complete 30 credits at UVA Wise (Previous college credits or AP does not count)
- Maintain a 3.0 GPA
