We recommend, but do not require submission of the Academic Evaluator Recommendation or the Mid-Term Report. The Mid-Term report should be sent after your mid-terms, which would mean this document could only be submitted after March 1. The common application and all other documents are due March 1.

APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL AID? The absolute deadline to turn in all financial aid paperwork for fall transfer applicants is April 1, 2020. Required materials include the FAFSA, the CSS/PROFILE and tax return information.
